The group will start at Conner • Rosenkranz Gallery, where **Joel Rosenkranz** will lead a discussion of the continued interest in American 19th century and early 20th century sculpture. The gallery is known to have some of the finest and most representative examples.

The later part of the program will deal with Post War and Contemporary American sculpture and Decorative Arts. The discussion will be led by **Professor Joan Marter**, Rutgers University.

Professor Marter will lead the group through the Noguchi Museum. Isamu Noguchi is considered one of the masters of 20th Century American Sculpture. We will see representative sculptures by Noguchi, as well as an exhibition of design objects.
